Luke 24: 11 But they did not believe the women, because their words seemed to them like nonsense.

A Faith that has never been tested, looked at minutely will not sustain you in your time of need. A Roman spear made sure of that Jesus died on the Cross vet 3 days after His crucifixion he showed himself to his friends and many other people. Many skeptics have held out for hard evidence, and they have a right to do so.

For me the most compelling evidence is found in how the disciples behaved when Mary told them Christ had risen.


But they did not believe the women, because their words seemed to them like nonsense.
