The Kirk Session and the Church have sustained a great loss by the death of Mr John Watson, who for 14 years was a devoted elder. Mr Watson was exemplary in his regular attendance at divine worship. Of a quiet and kindly disposition he was highly esteemed and trusted by all.

Another faithful member has been lost to us in the sudden death of Mr Wallace, whose courage, perseverance and industry were an example to us all.

Our sympathy goes out to the bereaved families.

The Sale of Work held on 15th December realised the sum of £82 17s 10d. The success of the sale was due to the energy of the ladies of the congregation who were supported by the whole parish. Of the money raised £50 was handed over to the Kirk Session to enable them to contribute £58 to the Foreign Mission Committee—the sum allocated to Aberdour by the General Assembly, in order that the debt incurred through causes arising out of the War might be cleared off and work in the Foreign field go on unimpeded—£28 10s for the maintenance of the Ministry—Small Livings Branch and £2 for the Sialkot Mission.

At the meeting of the Kirk Session it was found that the number of names on the Communion Roll was 550. Of those only 326 communicated during the year. While some were prevented by age and infirmity, there must be many who lightly esteemed their Church connection when they did not even once in the year fulfil our Lord's command to commemorate His death.

On the first Sunday of each month the service in Church is meant especially for parents and children. Certainly more could attend Church on those Sundays. The decay of the family pew, where parents and children sit together in the House of God is a distinct loss for in Church attendance, as in other things the example set by the parents influences the whole life of the children.

At a meeting of the ladies of the congregation held on 27th November, 1923, it was agreed that the Sale of Work should be postponed till the summer of 1924.

The Annual Business Meeting of the Kirk Session was held on 3rd January, 1924. At this meeting the Communion Roll was revised. The names of those who had not communicated for three years were removed from the Roll, except where old age or illness was the cause of absence from the Lord's Table.

Including the donation of £10 by the Ladies' Work Party, the amount raised for the Schemes of the Church was £41 18/-.
