This stone is erected by BARBARA GORDON in memory of her husband JAMES FINDLAY late farmer in Windyheads. He d. 14 Nov. 1781 aged 73.

Under this stone lies the body of WILLIAM FORSYTH sometime farmer in Bonnymoon d. 24 Apr. 1765 aged 88. Also of MARGARET BLACK his spouse d. 23 Sept. 1744 aged 57. Also of ANNE, GEORGE & MARGARET FORSYTHS their children; WILLIAM FORSYTH his son d. 4 Apr. 1793 aged 73.

This stone is erected by ROBERT GORDON in Tulhnamout (sic) to the memory of CHRISTIAN FORSYTH his spouse d. 24 Feb. 1750 aged 38 and ANNE GORDON their dau. d. 30 Apr. 1750.

Here lies the body of GEORGE BROWN who lived sometime in Quarreyhead and d. 25 Jan. 1777 aged 39. This stone is erected to his memory by MARGARET GORDON his surviving spouse.

This stone is by order of CHRISTEN and MARGARET BLACKS in memory of their father ALEXR. BLACK sometime farmer in Woodhead d. 15 Feb. 1743 aged 63. Also his son SAMUEL d. 1721.

Erected by ELSIE YOUNG, Newbigging in loved and honoured memory of her father ANDREW YOUNG d. 9 Apr. 1917 aged 90; her mother MARGARET MARTIN d. 5 Jan. 1870 aged 39; her stepmother ELIZABETH GLENNIE d. 13 Jan. 1892 aged 70. R.H.S. Also her brother JAMES MARTIN YOUNG, M.B., C.M. ophthalmic surgeon in Birmingham d. 12 Mar. 1929 aged 68; the said ELSIE YOUNG d. at Newbigging, Rosehearty 10 Feb. 1951 aged 86.

Heir lys the corps of AD sone to WD indweller in Aberdour who departed out of this lyf in the yeir of God 1646.

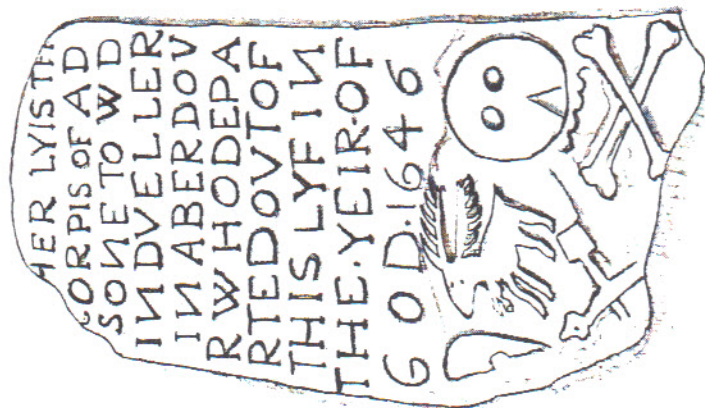
